HIRING PROCESS

The Riverside Township Police Department is a Civil Service Commission Police Department. If you wish to become a Riverside Police Officer, you must first take the New Jersey Civil Service Commission entry exam.

Once your application for the Civil Service Commission exam has been submitted, the NJ Civil Service Commission will notify you of when and where you will take the examination. If you pass the examination, you will be placed on a list of eligible candidates, where your ranking will be based on your test score. Preference is given to eligible veterans and Riverside Township residents.

If your position on the NJ Civil Service list is reached, you will be contacted by the Riverside Police Department, who will then schedule your interview and initiate your background investigation. Candidates who pass all facets of the background check and are selected for hire are then eligible candidates may then be contacted by the Riverside Police Department for an orientation and mentoring session followed by an interview, and commencement of a background investigation.
